<u>School Drop Off/Collection</u>: Many thanks for your continued co-operation with our drop off and collection procedures. Teaching time begins at 9.10 am so please ensure that your child is on time for school. We ask for your continued support with our collection times as it will mean that the numbers congregating at any one time will be minimised. Please note that there is no play-time at collection times. Please ensure that you "collect & go."

<u>Healthy Eating</u>: Please continue to pack a healthy lunch for your child. Fizzy drinks are not allowed in school. A copy of our "Healthy Eating Policy" can be found under the policies tab on the school website. Nut Free Zone: Scoil Cholmcille is a "Nut Free Zone" as we have a student with a nut allergy. We cannot allow children to bring any nut based products into school or in their packed lunches. We also ask children not to share their lunches.

<u>Christmas Raffle</u>: Our Christmas Raffle is back. Each family will receive 4 books of tickets to sell. <u>The tickets are €1</u> <u>each or 6 for €5.</u> The raffle tickets will be sent home next week. If you require additional books, please ask the class teacher. <u>This year our top prize is a Nintendo Switch</u>! The Parents Association are also looking for prize donations (sweets/biscuits/gift sets etc). Any prize donations may be dropped into the school next week in a bag labelled Christmas Raffle donation. <u>Covid-19 Procedures</u>: From November 29th, the following will be the procedure in schools. Antigen tests will be made available to the children in a primary school pod, where a child in the pod has had a PCR test that detected COVID-19. Where two or more confirmed cases of COVID-19 occur in a class, within a seven-day period, outside of a single pod, antigen testing will be offered to the full class. The tests will be sent to the children's parents by the HSE. Parents/guardians of a primary school child, who has been confirmed as having COVID-19 following a PCR test, are asked to inform their school's principal (via the school phone number, Class Dojo or email address). The school principal will then inform the parents of other children in the pod of a confirmed case. No personal details of the child will be shared. These parents will be provided with the option to receive free antigen tests for their child, which they will be able to order for delivery to their home. Children who are in a pod where a child has tested positive for COVID-19 can continue to attend school, whether they participate in antigen testing or not, provided that they are not experiencing symptoms of COVID-19. If a child displays any symptoms of COVID-19 they should self-isolate immediately and a parent or guardian should arrange a PCR test.
