School Admissions: Please note the following dates for school admissions:

We began accepting applications for the 2023/2024 school year on **Monday October 10**th. The application period will remain open until **November 7**th. Applicants will be notified of the decision on their application by **December 5**th. Applicants then have until **December 19**th to accept the offer of admission. **Please note that this is for applications the 2023/2024 school year only.**

<u>Healthy Eating:</u> Please continue to pack a healthy lunch for your child. Fizzy drinks are not allowed in school. A copy of our "Healthy Eating Policy" can be found under the policies tab on the school website.

Nut Free Zone: Scoil Cholmcille is a "Nut Free Zone" as we have a student with a nut allergy. We cannot allow children to bring any nut based products into school or in their packed lunches. We ask that parents avoid giving children peanuts, peanut butter sandwiches, other spreads containing nuts such as Nutella and snacks/bars containing nuts or labelled "may contain nut traces" in school lunches. We also ask children not to share their lunches.

<u>Birthday Invitations/Treats</u>: The school encourages parents to be mindful of other children and their feelings if you are inviting a select few to a birthday party. If this is the case we ask that you distribute birthday invitations in private and outside of school. This is to avoid unnecessary upset to children. We also ask that you do not send treats/cakes into school to mark your child's birthday as we cannot distribute them.

Anti-Bullying: We are constantly maintaining vigilance in this regard but it is important to highlight it on a regular basis. Our anti-bullying policy is available to read on www.mounthanoverns.ie. We would like to remind parents to be aware of your child's internet usage. In particular, the use of social-network websites can be a particular cause for concern. It is advisable for computer usage to take place in a room in the house where you can monitor activity.
