<u>Standardised Testing</u>: Please note the following dates for this year's standardised tests $(1^{st} - 6^{th})$ class children:

Drumcondra Reading Tests: May 9th/10th/11th.

Drumcondra Maths Tests: May 30th/31st

A standardised test is used to measure a child's achievement in English reading and maths compared to other children throughout the country at the same class level or age level. The English reading tests give information about how well your child can understand what he/she has read. The tests do not gather information on your child's written or spoken English. The maths test finds out how well your child can use numbers for different purposes and solve maths problems. The results of the tests will be communicated to you in the End of School Year report.

School Absence Reminder: If your child/ children are absent from school, please inform the school as soon as possible (via the school office or Class Dojo). The school must inform the NEWB (National Education Welfare Board) if a child is absent for more than 20 days in a school year. Where there is no absent note, absences are returned as "unexplained" which can be investigated by Tusla.

As part of our Attendance Strategy, school absence reminder texts have been sent to the parents of children who have been absent for 15 or more days so far this school year. The purpose of the text is so that you can be aware of your child's absences to date.
