<u>School Absence Reminder</u>: If your child/ children are absent from school, please inform the school as soon as possible (via Class Dojo or the school office). The school must inform the TUSLA/NEWB (National Education Welfare Board) if a child is absent for more than 20 days in a school year. Where there is no absent note, absences are returned as "unexplained" which may be investigated by TUSLA.

If your child is sick or is absent for other good reasons, no action will be taken by TUSLA- Child and Family Agency. However, if there is concern about your child's attendance at school or about the reasons given, you may be visited by an Educational Welfare Officer who will discuss your child's education with you.

<u>Music Generation</u>: Our Music Generation lessons for 3rd-6th class have resumed. These lessons are subsided by Music Generation and they will continue until May. The children are learning the violin and they have made great progress so far.

<u>Hot school Meals:</u> As previously announced, our expression of interest in the hot school meal scheme was accepted. We are currently trailing providers for this service. It will be at no extra cost to you. The suppliers will have an app where you can log on and choose what meal you would like for your child. They cater for dietary requirements and provide a detailed breakdown of the nutritional context of the meals. Once a supplier has been chosen, I will provide you with all the details regarding the app and how to download it. It is hoped that the meal scheme will be up and running after the Easter_holidays (April 8th).
