Standardised Testing: Please note the following dates for this year's standardised tests (1st – 6th class children):

Drumcondra Spelling Tests: February 27th & 28th Drumcondra Reading Tests: May 8th & 9th Drumcondra Maths Tests: May 28th & 29th

A standardised test is used to measure a child's achievement in English reading and maths compared to other children throughout the country at the same class level or age level. The English reading tests give information about how well your child can understand what he/she has read. The tests do not gather information on your child's written or spoken English. The maths test finds out how well your child can use numbers for different purposes and solve maths problems. The results of the tests will be communicated to you in the End of School Year report.

<u>School Visits</u>: On Monday we had a visit from Minister Helen McEntee and Cllr Sharon Tolan. They spoke with the 5th & 6th Class about their roles and responsibilities. Hot school Meals: As previously announced, our expression of interest in the hot school meal scheme was accepted. Our chosen provider is <u>'The Lunch Bag'</u>. It will be at no extra cost to you. They cater for dietary requirements and provide a detailed breakdown of the nutritional context of the meals.
