<u>School Books 2024:</u> In recognition of the cost of preparing children for the return to primary school each September, Minister for Education Norma Foley T.D. has announced funding to provide free schoolbooks, including workbooks and copybooks, again this school year. This scheme will eliminate the cost to parents of providing these resources.

Funding is being provided directly to primary schools by the Department to implement the scheme and schools will now have responsibility for providing schoolbooks, workbooks and copybooks to all children at the start of the school year.

All schoolbooks will remain the property of the school so that books can be re-used in future years. Schoolbooks will be provided on loan to children for the duration of the 2024/25 school year and must be returned to school at the end of the school year.
