<u>Standardised Testing:</u> Please note the following dates for this year's standardised tests $(1^{st} - 6^{th})$ class children:

Drumcondra Reading Tests: 6th, 7th& 8thof May. **Drumcondra Maths Tests**: 20th, 21st& 22nd of May.

A standardised test is used to measure a child's achievement in English reading and maths compared to other children throughout the country at the same class level or age level. The English reading tests give information about how well your child can understand what he/she has read. The tests do not gather information on your child's written or spoken English. The maths test finds out how well your child can use numbers for different purposes and solve maths problems. The results of the tests will be communicated to you in the End of School Year report.
