Confirmation:

The Confirmation Ceremony will take place on **Wednesday February 11th at 12 noon** in Duleek Church. The children must wear their school uniform for the Confirmation ceremony – no tracksuits.

Best wishes to the children, their families and their teachers as they prepare for these sacraments over the coming weeks.

School Absence Reminder: If your child/ children are absent from school, please inform the school as soon as possible (via Class Dojo or the school office). The school must inform the TUSLA/NEWB (National Education Welfare Board) if a child is absent for more than 20 days in a school year. Where there is no absent note, absences are returned as “unexplained” which may be investigated by TUSLA.

If your child is sick or is absent for other good reasons, no action will be taken by TUSLA- Child and Family Agency. However, if there is concern about your child’s attendance at school or about the reasons given, you may be visited by an Educational Welfare Officer who will discuss your child’s education with you.

Music Generation: Our Music Generation lessons for 3rd-6th class have resumed. These lessons are subsidised by Music Generation, and they will continue until May. The children are learning the violin and they have made great progress so far.

School Drop Off: We appreciate your cooperation with our morning drop-off routine.

To ensure a safe and smooth start to the day for all students, please remember to:

- ◆ Keep Moving: Please avoid blocking the flow of traffic for other cars.
- ◆ No Unsupervised Children: For safety, no child should be left unattended outside the school gates before or after school hours.
- ◆ No Pushing/Crowding: Children should not be pushing or rushing to get out of cars or towards the entrance.
- ◆ Parking: If you are parking only park in the designated areas and never park in areas which are restricted for buses, drivers with permits or individuals with special access.
- ◆ Exercise patience: On wet or busy mornings be patient and expect slight delays.
